THE ROLE OF THE CHAIR

Objective of the position:

The role of Chairperson is to provide Leadership for the Council and Congregation/Parish and to work alongside the Pastor/s in maintaining oversight of the Mission and Ministry of the Congregation/Parish

Primary responsibilities:

Provide Leadership for the Council and Congregation/Parish in fulfilling, enabling, promoting and supporting the Mission and Vision of the Congregation/Parish

Ensure the Congregation/Parish Council functions well and is managed effectively

Provide support to the Pastor, Staff and other Key Leaders .

Duties of the position include:

Presiding over Council and Annual General Meetings of the congregation/parish; monitoring the Council's effectiveness and assess its meeting processes and actions.

Setting the agenda for Council meetings in consultation with the Secretary and the pastor.

Setting the agenda for congregational meetings with the pastor and Council.

Listening and supporting the pastor and/or other paid staff with frequent open communication.

Being available to be consulted by the pastor and/or other paid staff on significant issues between Council meeting. Evaluating, with the Nominations Committee, the eligibility and suitability of potential candidates for nomination as Council members including undertaking any appropriate checks (eg police checks);

ensuring that all elected and appointed officers and committees effectively carry out their assigned duties.

Encouraging and cooperating with all office bearers.

Supporting the implementation of District and National policies and procedures; and communicating with District Offices matters of importance.
