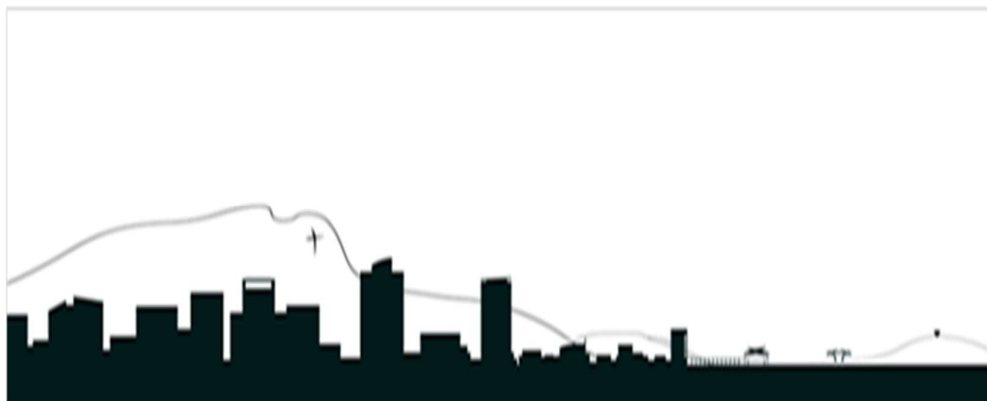

If you would like to donate food items, please leave them in the marked box in the morning tearoom. Monetary donations may also be made by placing your donation in an envelope in the offering bowl marked 'meal bank' or by direct deposit to the church bank account with the reference 'meal bank'. Thank you for your continued support of this ministry.

A meal bank package generally contains the following items.

- cereal -healthy
- long-life milk
- baked beans/spaghetti
- jar spaghetti sauce
- packet noodles or spaghetti
- 1kg packet rice
- Tinned vegetables (peas, carrots, corn etc)
- tinned soup
- tinned casserole
- tinned tuna/ham
- tinned fruit
- packet pasta & sauce mix
- biscuits
- bar soap
- rolls of toilet paper
- toothpaste & toothbrushes
- enviro bag
